Benefits:

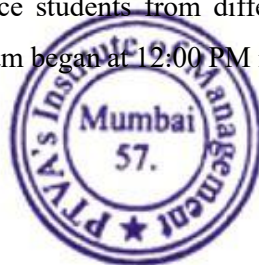
- Participants motivated towards innovation & Entrepreneurship.
- Participants understood the opportunities and challenges faced by an entrepreneur during his entrepreneurial journey.



The Science Association, in collaboration with the Entrepreneurship Development Cell and PTVAIM's IIC, hosted a My Story - Motivational Session by Successful Entrepreneur - Ravindra Pratap Singh on 28th October 2023 from 12:00 PM to 2:30 PM at third floor auditorium Sathaye college. There were 50 participants attending the session.

The event was coordinated by assistant professors Smt Sukruta Pethe and Dr S.P. Shinde. Approximately 50 undergraduate science students from different streams as well as a few faculty members were in attendance. The program began at 12:00 PM in the third-floor auditorium with a brief

introduction to the Science Association by Dr Shinde, followed by Mr Singh's presentation. Mr Singh spoke about his start-up named Clairifier, through which he is in the process of developing affordable outdoor air purifiers.

He outlined the steps he took in building a company from the ground up, starting with identifying a problem, namely, the lack of affordable and self-cleaning air purification solutions with a small profile. Upon identifying this niche, he developed his solution with the support of his undergraduate institution, RJ College, and went on to win awards at multiple competitions. He has secured investment in his company and hopes his purifiers will be installed on Mumbai's streets soon. To this end, he has filed a patent application.

The presentation was followed by a Q&A session where members of the audience asked him about his opinions on topics such as entrepreneurship, innovation, leadership as well as the development of his product. In addition, Dr Shinde spoke about the importance of practical education and the scope of student input in curriculum framing under the NEP 2020. The program then concluded with a vote of thanks.
