

Report on Orientation session for PTVAIM's Innovation & Start-up Policy for teaching and non-teaching staff members of PTVAIM

25th June 2021

Objective: To orient the faculty regarding PTVAIM's Innovation & start-up policy 2020-2021.

Description: An online Orientation meeting for the faculty, and non-teaching staff of PTVAIM about the PTVAIM Innovation and startup policy 2020-2021. The meeting was facilitated by Dr. Sucheta Pawar (Dean- COEI, PTVAIM's NISP Coordinator).

Report on: NISP- PTVAIM's Innovation & start-up policy 2020-2021.

Dr. Sucheta Pawar started the meeting by greeting everyone. Then she proceeded to explain what NISP and NISP policy is. She stated that NISP policy gives a solid framework of guidelines for all higher educational institutes on the basis of which they can frame 'an Innovation & Start-up Policy' of their own which will lead to develop entrepreneurial culture at campus. Lack of money will not be an issue where doing entrepreneurial promotion is concerned since NISP guidelines already have made provision for that too. She explained NISP guidelines elaborately due to which pursuing innovation and start-up projects along with their respective courses by undergraduate & postgraduate students have become easier. She further elaborated provisions made in the policy where teachers involved in E cell activities as well as teachers who wish to get into some start-up venture are considered.

Dr. Sucheta further explained all the steps that were taken to frame PTVAIM's Innovation & start-up Policy with mention of all members of policy framing committee and members of IIC council who are now the members of policy implementation committee.

She further spoke about the start-up ecosystem that is created by COEI for all the colleges of parent trust Parle Tilak Vidyalaya Association.

The policy document was shown to all the members and first phase policy provisions were elaborated. She further discussed how some guidelines of policy which are good if implemented, cannot be incorporated in the current policy since we need to seek permission from the University of Mumbai since PTVAIM is the college affiliated to the university. She said that a request letter is sent to the university of Mumbai for which response is not received. Till all the required permission is not received, certain points related to giving attendance concession, sabbatical to teachers, extra grade points to students cannot be introduced. So the first phase policy document does not have these provisions. She expressed her hope that in one
