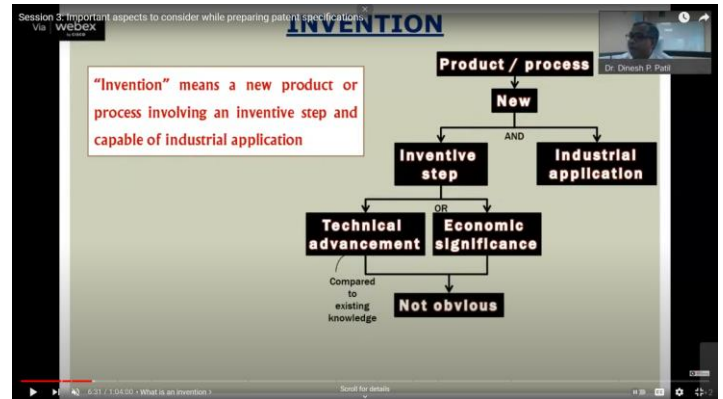
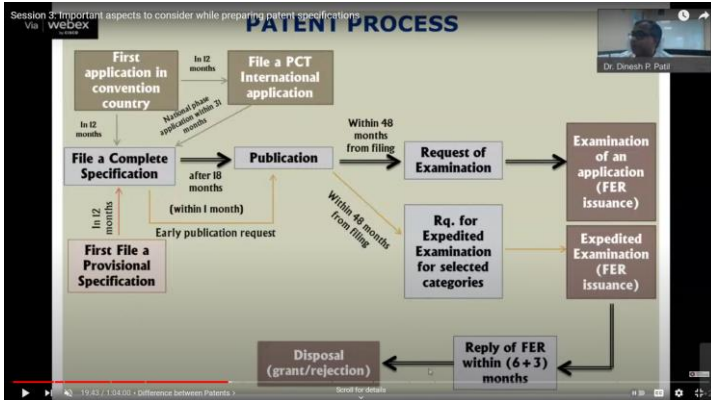

SPECIFICATIONS

- Provisional specification (s.9)
 - claims not mandatory
 - cognate application
 - complete treated as provisional
 - cancelling provisional and post-dating
- Complete specification (s.10)
 - fully and particularly describe the invention
 - disclose the best method of performing the invention
 - end with claims defining the scope of invention
 - drawings
 - abstract
 - deposition of biological material in IDA
 - disclosure of source & Geographical Origin

CLAIMS

- Define the scope of invention for which protection is claimed
- Invention=Claims=Patent
- Define the scope of invention in technical terms
- Shall relate to a single invention, or to a group of inventions linked so as to form a single inventive concept
- Shall be clear & succinct and shall be fairly based on matter disclosed
- Importance
 - During prosecution
 - After grant
