### Report on a Celebration of National Innovation Day

On 25<sup>th</sup> November 2022, PTVAIM's IIC collaboration with Paranjape Vidyalaya English Medium organized a workshop on ideation from 9:00 am to 11:00 am for the students of standard VI to celebrate National Innovation day. There were 50 participants attending the workshop.

The workshop commenced with an introduction of the Main Facilitator, Ms. Ridhima Mahabal. She is a faculty coordinator at COEI and an innovation ambassador at the Ministry of Education's Innovation Council.

Ms. Ridhima Mahabal began the workshop with an introduction to the national innovation day and started with the concept of Ideation and Innovation. Concepts were explained via audio-visuals and real-life examples were used to make it exciting and she taught the students how to turn problems into solutions. To help the audience thoroughly understand the concepts, they were engaged with some entertaining and educational exercises. The workshop concluded with an explanation of the link between creativity and problem solving, and how problems noticed can be used to build innovative solutions. A minor idea brainstorming session was taken where the students created the solutions of their problems. Idea forms were given to each form and they were encouraged to write down the problems they had identified and solutions they had devised.

Later, a short Q&A session was conducted to wipe away any doubts the audience must have had, with each question being handled in simple language and in detail. The idea forms were collected for further scrutiny. Lastly, the audience and the attending staff members presented Ms. Ridhima with applause for the workshop.
