

Wings2Vision Business plan Competition

2018-19

Report: Undergraduate and post graduate students from colleges across Mumbai were encouraged to send their business plans, the registration and idea form for which was available on COEI website; www.coei.in; from 5th January, 2019 to 22nd January, 2019. Total 74 ideas were received from Sathaye College, M.L. Dahanukar College, Mulund College and other colleges from Mumbai.



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2019-20

Report: Undergraduate and postgraduate students from colleges across Mumbai were encouraged to register for a three-day basic Entrepreneurship Development Program, which would give them direct access to the B-plan competition. The Basic EDP was conducted from January 15th, 2020 to January 18th, 2020. The student teams were asked to present their ideas in front of industry mentors, who reviewed their ideas and provided guidelines for improvement on the last day of the EDP. A total of 39 ideas from 75 students (individuals and teams) from Sathaye College, M.L. Dahanukar College, Mulund College, , Maniben Nanavati Women's College and other colleges in Mumbai were assessed and reviewed on the last day of the Basic EDP. The student teams were assigned faculty mentors who are trained entrepreneurship educators



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2020-21

Report: COEI started the preparations by inviting different educational institutions to participate in the Wings2vision 2021. There were 141 participants from Sathaye College, M.L. Dahanukar College, Mulund College, Maniben Nanavati Women's College and other colleges from Mumbai for Wings2vision 2021. On 23rd January 2021 a day long Problem identification symposium was held where 4 sessions were facilitated by the industry experts. After the symposium 3 days Basic Entrepreneurship Development Program was organised by COEI to help participants learn effective ways to plan, start their business from 4th February to 6th February. After the EDP participants had their panel rounds for evaluation of their business plan. The Submission of business plan and presentation (First round) was held on 10th & 11th February where 48 teams were evaluated. The final round was held on 27th February, 2021 where 10 teams presented their business plan in detail.



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2021-22

Report: PTVAIM's IIC and COEI organized a pitching round on 5th February 2022 for participants of their Entrepreneurship Development Program conducted in month of January. The students got 3 days training and a chance to pitch their ideas a week later in front of industry panellists. 43 teams from Sathaye College, M.L. Dahanukar College, Mulund College and other colleges from Mumbai participated in the virtual pitching event. They had 10 mins time to pitch their business idea. The panellists gave invaluable inputs to the students which would help in the further pitching rounds that would be held as a part of the b-plan contest. The students got the much-required exposure and inputs. Some industry experts also expressed interest in providing hand holding to some teams. The pitching round, helped the students to build, develop and further strengthen their ideas for the business plan competition which started 12th February 2022.



2022-23 (Start-up EXPO)

Report: PTVA's Start-up Expo 2023 was conceptualized and organized by PTVA's Institute of Management's Centre of Entrepreneurship and Innovation on 4th March 2023 at PTVA's Institute of Management from 9.30 am to 9.30 pm. There were 23 student teams participated and more than 600 people visited the event. START-UP EXPO 2023 showcased innovative business ideas, products, services and prototypes made by school and college students of Parle Tilak Vidyalaya Association's 5 schools and 4 colleges. Total 23 business ideas were showcased on the day. The expo was inaugurated by Mr. Dipan Sahu- Assistant Director of Ministry of Education's Innovation Council (MIC), Government of India and Mr. G. Ramakrishnan- Co-founder and Director of Galaxy Surfactants. The guests visited each stall and shared their insights with the business teams. President of PTVA Shri.
