1) About Parle Tilak Vidyalaya Association's Institute of Management (PTVVA's IM)

## 3) Purpose of Collaboration

## 5) Tenure

This MOU shall come in effect from the date of affixing signature by both the Parties and shall remain valid for a period of two (02) years from that date. Either party may by way of three (03) months' notice to terminate this MOU with any written notice by one party to other party, expressing its intent to terminate this MoU.

## 6) Coordination Between Facilitators

Both the Parties shall nominate one or more senior representative/ officer, who shall be the point of contact/ facilitator for the purposes of this MOU. The facilitators of both the Parties shall maintain regular contact with the other Party as well as propose and review different programs & other activities in furtherance of objectives of the purpose and objectives envisioned under this MOU. The Facilitators may also be required to report to and coordinate with different committees or boards for the purposes of this MOU, as may be necessary.
