## Scholarship/Freeship Policy

PTVA's Institute of Management is a part of Parle Tilak Vidyalyaya Association, an Educational Trust known for imparting value-based, quality education at affordable fees through its 5 schools, 3 colleges, 1 management institute, catering to around 27,000 students annually.

### **Objective:**

PTVA's Institute of Management aims at imparting quality education to the maximum number of eligible students at affordable fees, in alignment with the ideology of Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak after whom our Parent trust PTVA was established in 1921.

We believe in being an Equal Opportunity Provider for all our current and prospective students. Considering the financial constraints that prohibit many capable youngsters from pursuing higher education, PTVAIM encourages and guides all such eligible students to apply for Freeships and scholarships and gives them all required cooperation in obtaining the benefits of these schemes.

The Institute provides scholarships to the students as follows.

1. Students are provided with an **installment facility to pay their fees** as PTVAIM believes that no eligible and capable student shall be deprived of education due to financial constraints.
2. Various non-government scholarships and freeships which are available to the students studying in PTVAIM, are communicated to all deserving and eligible students and all required guidance and support is provided by the Institute to the students applying for these scholarships and freeships.
3. **PTVAIM provides scholarship to the students** as per the rules and regulations imparted by the Central and State Government of India.
