4. Policy

4.1 Responsible use of Resources available for research

PTVA's Institute of Management provides statistical tools, databases and well equipped library resources for use as research tools to meet the research objectives. Orientation regarding the way database and other resources can be used as well as care to be taken while using these resources is organized every year for students and teachers. Students and teaching staff members are expected to utilize these resources optimally.

4.2 Teaching Staff members Research Contribution

Teaching staff members need to participate in research related activities through participating in Research Conferences, Workshops, and Faculty Development Programmes as per the norms of UGC/AICTE. Teaching staff members are also expected to publish research papers in journals which are part of UGC CARE/Scopus/ ABDC, as well as can contribute articles for ISBN/ISSN journals. Teachers are encouraged to write books or contribute chapters in the book.

4.3 Teaching Staff members Encouraging Student Research

Teaching staff members are expected to encourage student's research through joint research work like joint research papers, minor and major paid and unpaid research projects as well as guiding

students for various research oriented competitions. Students are encouraged to publish research papers in UGC CARE/ABDC/SCOPUS. In case of such publications by students or jointly by teachers and students, registration/ publication charges will be borne by the institute.

4.4 Motivating Research at PTVA'IM

Research paper publications done by faculty members or faculty members along with student's joint publications in UGC care listed and indexed journal/Scopus/ABDC/Web of Science Journals have always been encouraged in the Institute. The fees for these publications are reimbursed by the institute as an incentive to the faculty members and students.

4.5 Ethical Research

Teaching staff members as well as students are expected to furnish exhaustive bibliography for every published as well as unpublished research work. Every research work accepted by PTVAIM will go through plagiarism detection software and work with similarity report of less than 20% will only be accepted at PTVAIM.
