- **Key Reforms and Initiatives:** Detailed discussion on the major reforms proposed in school and higher education sectors.


Session 1: Structural Changes in Education

- Participants engaged in a Q&A session with experts to clarify doubts and gain deeper insights into specific aspects of the NEP.


Panel Discussion
