

Report on KAPILA Program

The workshop started with Dr Abhay Jere welcoming all the participants to the online workshop. The reason to launch KAPILA, he stated that India lags far behind in global leadership of patents. If India wants to be a knowledge-based economy then India needs to generate ideas which will not only have impact within the country but also have application across the globe. He also shared a data of different countries who file patents and shared that South Korea is the top most in filing patents across the globe & the fact that India does not even come in top 10. He also shared that out of all the patents filed from India, most of the patents are made by NRIs instead of the residents of India.

Through KAPILA multiple interventions will be made, Multiple online sessions will be held to sensitize Higher institutions about the need of IP. He further shared that Mr. Om Prakash Gupta nominated 3 people who will help potential people innovative ideas file their patent. He shared that India has a target of filing 10000 IP & AICTE is willing to fund patent for institutions under AICTE (Upto 25K-30K per IP) It was informed that through KAPILA the IIC will be creating a huge network of experts who are aware of IP filing and connect them with Higher education institutions.

Dr Abhay Jere shared his opinion on Why do higher education institutions need to establish IIC? In his opinion he said that IIC's main agenda is to create a mentoring & handholding process where potential students, teachers, staff get the support for their innovations related to entrepreneurship. He shared that IIC started in 2018 and now they have 1700 IICs spread across 28 states, 5 union territories. He also stated that 10000+activities were done by IIC 1 & in IIC -2 26500 + activities were done.

Mr. Om Prakash Gupta - Controller general trademark office was invited to share some words and he stated that at present India may have less patents but in ancient Indian time, we were the most advanced knowledge based country, the reason we went down was because India culturally has a habit of sharing and many times India have shared their ideas without doing patents. The number of scientific publications made by India is a lot but India does not always make intellectual property out of those research/outcomes. India has many such scholars with good innovations therefore KAPILA is very important for our country.

Shri Sanjay Dhotre Sir then shared his hopes that KAPILA initiative will help fill the huge gap in our patent's lags worldwide & invited Mr. Deepan Sahu to share reports about IIC performance rating.


Mr. Deepan Sahu informed everyone that the Activities are categorized in 3 categories namely: MIC Driven Activities, Self-Driven activities, IIC Annual calendar activities. He also shared the performance rating on the basis of activities done by IIC annually.

He informed the participants that the rating scale is of 1-5. 1 being the lowest score and 5 being the highest. Later he shared that more than 125 institutions have received 5 stars,90 institutes have 4.5 stars, 78 institutions have received 4 stars in the year of 2020.

Later he informed that institutions which received the rating of 5,4.5 & 4 will be playing the role of guides and mentors to other institutes in IIC-3

The session was concluded by sharing a video of all the achievements & hard work of the IIC team & the Launch of IP Literacy Initiative.
