

Report on e-workshop titled Copyrights for Academicians

PTVAIM's IIC and PTVAIM's business incubator Centre of Entrepreneurship and Innovation organized 2 days E-workshop titled Copyrights for Academicians on 20th and 21st October 2020 from 4 pm to 6 pm on both days. The session was facilitated by Solicitor Darius Dalal Senior Partner at Jehangir, Gulabbhai, Bilimoria & Daruwallah. The session was open for members of teaching fraternity (school teachers and college professors) and 32 teachers attended the workshop.

The objective of the session was to give teachers an understanding of different types of IPR, especially copyrights. Sol. Dalal also explained the various works for which copyrights could be procured by teachers. On day 1 he discussed different types of IPRs and why securing an IPR would be beneficial. He explained how one has to carefully read documents that researchers and academicians sign when they submit research papers, articles for publication. He also covered the copyrights aspect involved when one writes books. Day 1 ended with a question answer round. On Day 2 Sol. Dalal addressed few more questions that the teachers posed. He then guided the teachers on how one can apply for copyrights by oneself.

The session was a myth buster and eye opener for all participants and they greatly appreciated the initiative. All participants were given E-certificates of participation.
