Through his consistent contribution towards driving innovation and business excellence Mr. Joshi has been awarded as most trusted CEO in May 2017 by WCRC, Singapore, Maharashtra startup award 2020, National startup award 2022, Most prominent contributors to innovation by world innovation congress in Feb 2023. He is regularly invited to various premium educational institutions to interact with their students and share knowledge and wisdom that covers a very large spectrum ranging from technical topics to societal issues to professional challenges.

The session started with understanding the importance of treating women equally everywhere. Mr. Sameer emphasised the fact that women should be respected and should be at the centre stage in every aspect of business as well as all other domains in the industry. He shared that the women in his life are his first inspiration. First was his mother who accompanied him in this session, inspired him to be a good person and a good man. He said a mother is the best nurse (irrespective of qualifications). He also quoted a social principle of how mother and motherland is more prestigious than heaven. Second was his wife, who inspired him to be humble, down to earth and contribute towards social upliftment, support women. Third were his daughters who inspired him to pursue his passion. Fourth were his teachers and his 'guru-mata' Dr. Snehlata Deshmukh (Ex-Vice Chancellor of University of Mumbai) who inspired him to work efficiently and encouraged him in every step of his life.

Mr. Sameer Joshi and his team at Transcender Services Pvt. Ltd and iTransform group tirelessly work towards the upliftment of women especially belonging to the marginalised society i.e prisoners and sex workers, bringing them back into the mainstream. iTransform group attempts to address key concern of Educated unemployment. They also focus on transforming today's youth to employable workforce through their innovation, and industry driven skill development programs. Creating safe houses for sex workers in Pune, who want to educate and get back to living a better life, building social consciousness is among one of the various activities they venture into. Then he moved on towards the inspirational women in India in various sectors right from India's first lady

He also shared an informative video on the history of Women's Day which depicted the struggle women had to go through in the early 20th Century. But with endless protests starting from 1903 laid a foundation to the equality and awareness that we have today about respecting women and treating them equally. Mr. Joshi also emphasised on the fact that the ratio of Women to Man in India has improved, but still the inequality exists. There was a significant brainstorming done within the participants and the faculty so as to find out the causes for inequality and the probable solutions where there is a scope of improvement. Audience got to know each others point of view. Mr. Joshi also stated that we are a part of the GIG economy and now the policy for women's day is DigiTall". He suggested that women should be involved in the key areas such as Personal, Economic, Social, and most importantly Decision Making in each and every corporate and household.

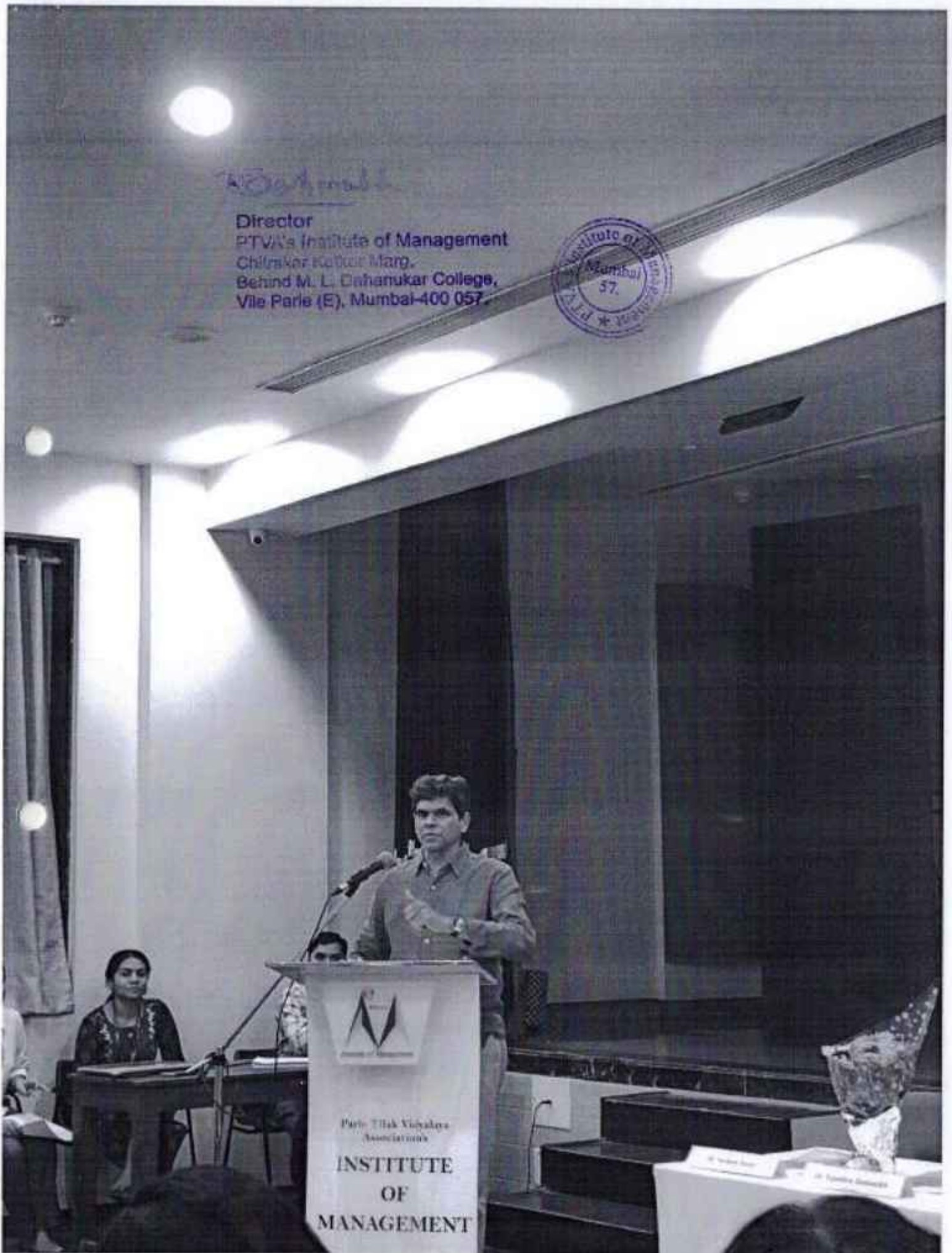
