PTVAIM's Wet Waste Management Process

The process followed is as follows:

- 1) Wet waste collectors are placed at four prominent locations at the institute where the wet waste is generated.
- 2) Daily wet waste is collected in these four green bin called as 'Wet waste collectors'. The bins used are made of recycled plastic.
- 3) Collected wet waste is aggregated in the bigger bins called as 'Wet waste aggregators'. Dried bagasse (Sugarcane waste) is placed at the base of every aggregator bin.
- 4) Every day the enaculum powder i.e., one tea spoon is sprinkled on the wet waste to speed fast composting.
- 4) After the aggregator bin is full it is kept aside for min 15 days till compost is partially ready. Meanwhile wet waste aggregation is done with the help of second bin (Wet waste aggregator)
- 6) Once the compost is partially ready, it is mixed with soil in 'Composting bin' during rains and 'Composting pits' of campus after rains. Within a month, the compost mixed soil becomes ready to be applied to the plants as fertilizer.

- ✓ Vegetable Peels

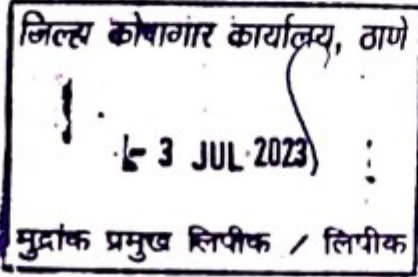

- iii) Collaborating with PTVAIM shall allow Aakar Mumbai to conduct sensitization drives in the areas of environmental sustainability.
- iv) Collaborating with PTVAIM shall also allow Aakar Mumbai to introduce eco-friendly practices environmental practices to the students' community.
- v) Aakar Mumbai often works closely with local communities. By collaborating with PTVAIM, they can extend their reach and involve students in community-based initiatives. This engagement can strengthen community bond, promote responsible waste disposal, and encourage participation in the recycling programs.

2) Areas of Cooperation

- i) PTVAIM shall dedicate a space within the premises to place a bin that shall be used by the students, staff, and members of the local community to deposit their recyclable plastic waste.
- ii) If the PTVAIM collects monthly minimum of 25kg of dry waste in a month, a vehicle shall be sent to by Aakar Mumbai to collect this dry waste including recyclable plastic. In case the dry waste

- including recyclable plastic collected by PTVAIM is less than 25 kg, PTVAIM shall send a representative to Aakar Mumbai to drop dry waste including recyclable plastic.
- iii) After 1 year of the successful completion of this collaboration, the certificate shall be issued by the Aakar Mumbai to PTVAIM to that effect.
 - iv) Aakar Mumbai shall organize field visits to their recycling facilities for hands on experience for students of PTVAIM.
 - v) Aakar Mumbai shall organize awareness campaigns on plastic pollution and plastic recycling for the students of PTVAIM at PTVAIM premises free of charge.
 - vi) A few of MMS Semester IV students of PTVAIM shall work with Aakar Mumbai for a period of three weeks to complete their Social Relevance Project which is a requirement as per the syllabus of the University of Mumbai without expecting any stipend in lieu of the work. Aakar Mumbai shall issue a Certificate of Internship to these students.

3) Tenure

This MOU shall come in effect from the date of affixing signature by both the Parties and shall remain valid for a period of three (03) years from that date.


4) Financials



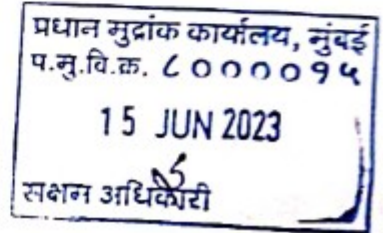

2) About Shreedhar (Anna) Tawde Gram Vikas Sanstha (NGO)

Shri. Shreedhar (Anna) Tawde established a cooperative society for mango growers, focusing on collective cultivation and marketing. Shreedhar (Anna) Tawde Gram Vikas Sanstha is a trust formed in 2016 by family members in memory of the late Shreedhar (Anna) Tawde. The trust aims to carry forward Anna's legacy of social reforms through people's participation. Their work centers around Gram Vikas (village development), which involves identifying and addressing real problems faced by rural communities. They employ Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) to engage with the community and prioritize critical issues.

3) Purpose of Collaboration

The major objectives of the collaboration are:

- i. To conduct an impact assessment study of the range of initiatives taken by the Shreedhar (Anna) Tawde Gram Vikas Sanstha towards health, education, infrastructure, financial resources, environmental aspects etc. of the village based on the recommendations mentioned in the PRA.
- ii. To propose and participate in new initiatives for further development of the village & villagers with holistic approach.

4) Areas of Cooperation

Parle Tilak Vidyalaya Association Institute of Management and Shreedhar (Anna) Tawde Gram Vikas Sanstha (NGO) would partner in the following areas:

- i. The PTVA's Institute of Management would provide students for conducting the door-to-door survey at the village, analyzing the data, submitting reports for further development of the village.
- ii. Any visit by the students and staff members of PTVAIM for the purpose of this collaboration shall not exceed 04 days at a time.
- iii. Further a presentation would be made to the trustee of NGO before submitting the final report of the study. Data collected during the assessment will be used and shared with NGO.
- iv. The data will be used by PTVAIM for academic purposes regarding the Social Relevance Project for the participating students in their 4th semester of MMS program.
- v. NGO would provide travel, lodging, and boarding and all other incidental expenses of the students for the visit which is covered under the scope of project.
- vi. The project shall be used for PTVAIM's Green Club activation for youth empowerment towards environmental sustainability.
- vii. The safety and security of the students and staff of PTVAIM during the tenure of such visits while conducting the survey shall be the responsibility of Shreedhar (Anna) Tawde Gram Vikas Sanstha (NGO).




8) Financials

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. OBJECTIVE AND PRINCIPLES

1. The objective of this MOU is to foster collaboration and to facilitate the exchange of knowledge based on reciprocity, best efforts, mutual benefits and frequent interactions.
2. This MOU will be carried out within the framework of the respective laws and regulations of the institutions and is intended to create legally binding rights or obligations.

2. SCOPE OF THE MOU

1. Both Parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge as well as faculty members in their research and consultancy.
