PTVAIM's Wet Waste Management Process

The process followed is as follows:

- 1) Wet waste collectors are placed at four prominent locations at the institute where the wet waste is generated.
- 2) Daily wet waste is collected in these four green bin called as 'Wet waste collectors'. The bins used are made of recycled plastic.
- 3) Collected wet waste is aggregated in the bigger bins called as 'Wet waste aggregators'. Dried bagasse (Sugarcane waste) is placed at the base of every aggregator bin.
- 4) Every day the enaculum powder i.e., one tea spoon is sprinkled on the wet waste to speed fast composting.
- 4) After the aggregator bin is full it is kept aside for min 15 days till compost is partially ready. Meanwhile wet waste aggregation is done with the help of second bin (Wet waste aggregator)
- 6) Once the compost is partially ready, it is mixed with soil in 'Composting bin' during rains and 'Composting pits' of campus after rains. Within a month, the compost mixed soil becomes ready to be applied to the plants as fertilizer.

Waste Management Mechanism

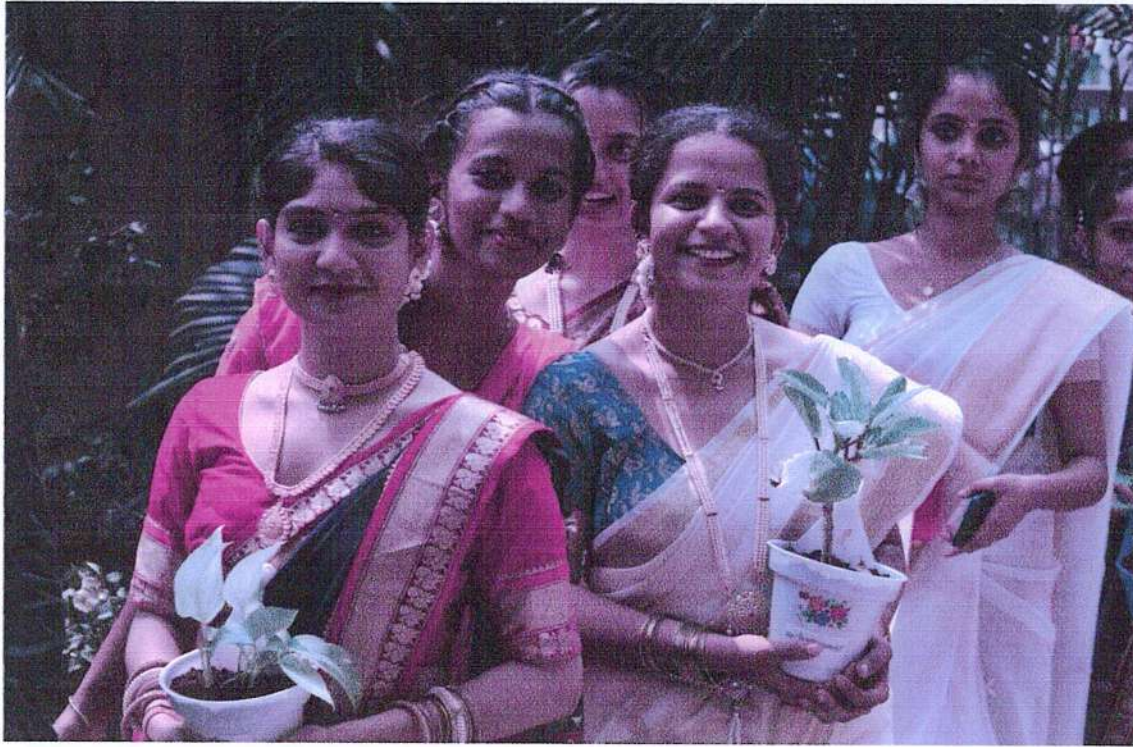

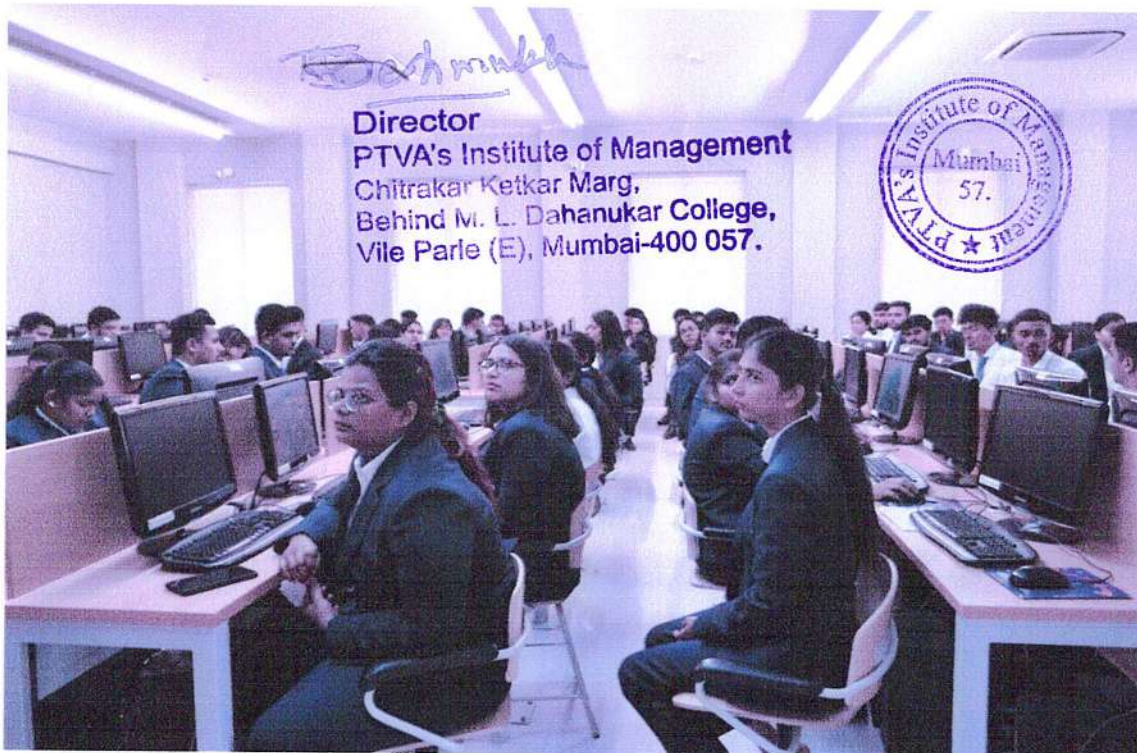
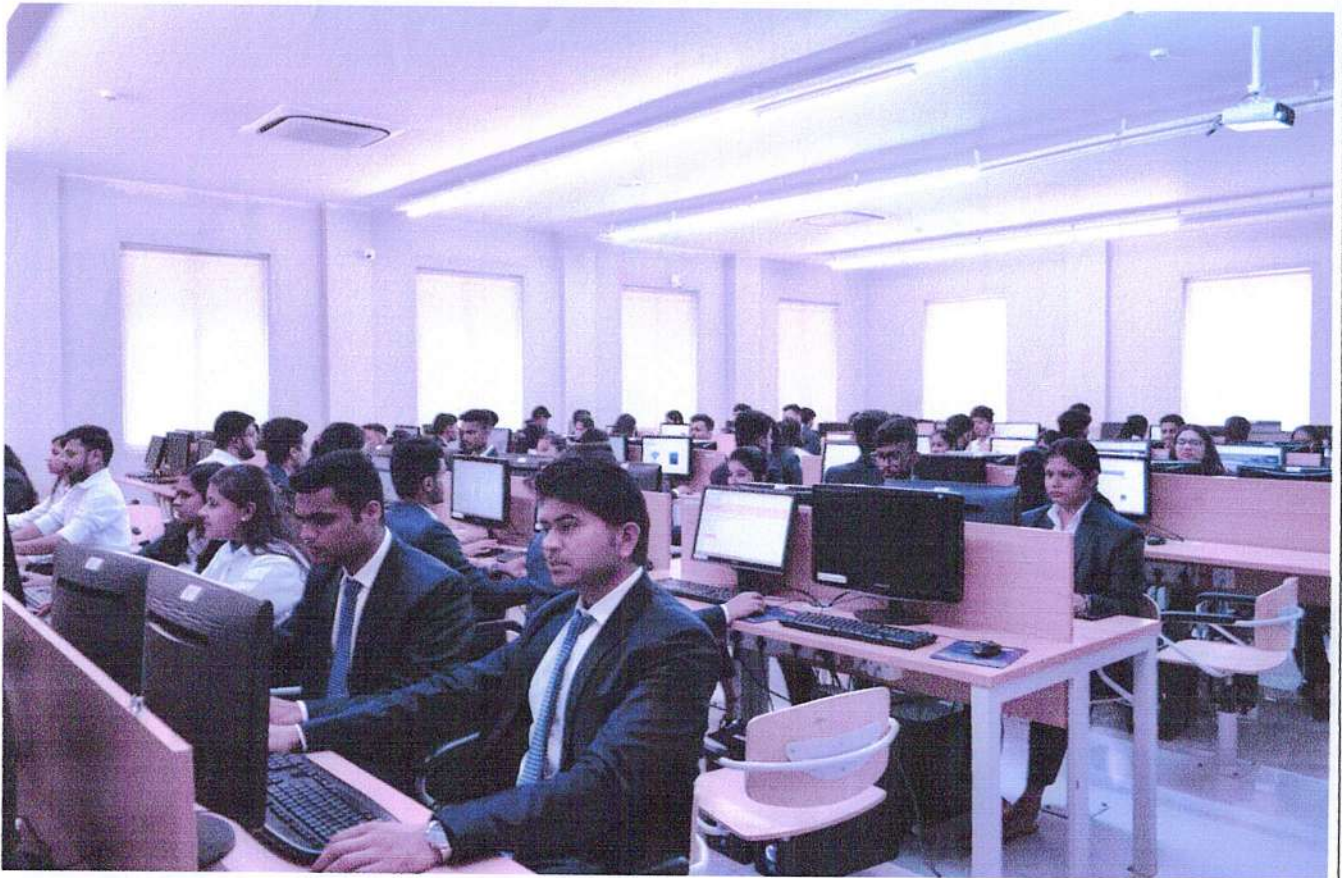
