1) Minutes of the last meeting of Anti-Ragging Committee were read and confirmed.

2) Director, Dr. Tejashree Deshmukh welcomed all members and introduced them to each other. She explained the concept of "Anti-Ragging Committee" to the new members of the meeting and informed them that an affidavit is taken from the students during the time of admission that ragging is strictly prohibited in the Institute.

3) Dr. Tejashree Deshmukh said that it is mandatory for each student and their parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at www.amanmovement.org. This is the first step towards the compliance of anti-ragging regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in the Institution. The Anti-Ragging committee members list and posters are displayed on the notice board. All the Do's and Don'ts were explained to the students at the time of Orientation program which is the first entry level program for the newly admitted students of MMS course. The detailed procedure of filling the Online Anti-Ragging Affidavit was explained to the students by the admin staff and it was completed successfully.

4) Dr. Tejashree Deshmukh informed the committee of the availability of a mental health counsellor to guide the students to cope with mental stress which is especially important in the current situation.

5) Dr. Tejashree Deshmukh informed that Ragging is strictly prohibited at PTVA's Institute of Management & it is a punishable offence. While referring to the guidelines of AICTE/ UGC in this regard she mentioned about the details of Anti-Ragging committee members along with any violation of AICTE regulations (Prevention & prohibition of Ragging in technical institutions, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting technical education) dated 01/07/2009.

6) She put on record that no incidence of ragging has ever taken place at PTVA's Institute of Management till date. Regular interaction including counselling of the students, by the faculty members along with all the Non-teaching staff members has helped us to achieve a status of Zero tolerance & no reporting of ragging.

7) Dr. Tejashree Deshmukh informed the new members about "Sakhi Box", CCTV installed in the Institute and online grievance redressal mechanism which is available on PTVAIM website.

8) Ms. Shilpa Chandolika suggested that Responsible Netism would like to conduct sessions with the students in every quarter to help them understand the importance of cybercrime and cyber safety.

9) The CR's who are the members of Anti-Ragging Committee also mentioned that they have not received any complaints of ragging from the students.

10) Dr. Tejashree Deshmukh concluded the meeting by thanking all the members for taking out their valuable time and attending this meeting.
